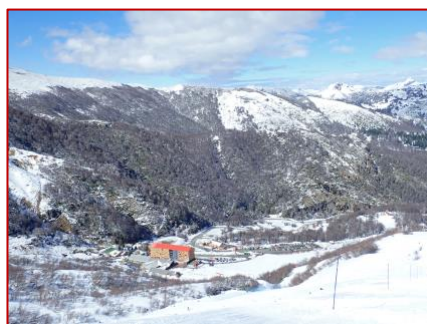

## SCHEDULE:

Thu, Sep 3: Depart North America and Europe for Nevados de Chillan, Chile.

Fri, Sep 4: Arrive in Santiago, Chile. Coach bus to hotel (about 5 hours) with lunch stop.

Sat, Sep 5: Acclimatization day - Free skiing and drills on slalom skis with coaches.

Sun, Sep 6: Slalom training (morning + afternoon sessions).

Mon, Sep 7: Slalom training (morning). Chalk talk (afternoon) + free time.

Tue, Sep 8: Free skiing drills on GS skis (morning); GS training (afternoon).

Wed, Sep 9: GS training (morning). Chalk talk (afternoon) + free time.

Thu, Sep 10: SG training (morning). Get ready to race!

Fri, Sep 11: FIS Masters Cup – 2xSG (2nd SG counts as a stand-alone race and for the Alpine Combined)

Sat, Sep 12: FIS Masters Cup – SL/AC (1st run counts for the Alpine Combined. 2<sup>nd</sup> + 3<sup>rd</sup> runs = SL race)

Sun, Sep 13: FIS Masters Cup – 2xGS (one run per race).

Mon, Sep 14: Depart Nevados de Chillan.

Tue, Sep 15: Arrive home.

*Note: You must be a member of your country's national governing body for alpine ski racing, e.g. US Ski and Snowboard, and hold an FIS Masters license to compete.*
